8. To perform Information Security risk assessment and carry out security audits.
9. To promote Information Security awareness programmes and conduct capacity building exercises.
10. To manage Information Security incidents and carry out Threat and Vulnerability Assessments.
11. To proactively manage and monitor major systems and devices using appropriate security tools to assess potential items of risk and vulnerability to avoid hacking and any other unauthorised and suspicious activity.
12. To assist the Ministry in the formulation of Government policies and legislation related to cybersecurity and cybercrime.
13. To promote international collaboration with regional and international agencies in the area of cybersecurity and cybercrime.
14. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Information Security Specialist (CERT-MU) in the roles ascribed to him.
