Implementation of the Recommendations on Representations arising out of the Errors, Omissions and Anomalies Committee (EOAC) Report 2013

Please refer to this Ministry's Circular letter No. 7 of 2014 on the above subject.

- 2. Supervising officers are informed that with regard to paragraph 1 of the recommendations of the Committee, officers who have proceeded on pre-retirement leave or have retired from the service on or after 01 January 2014 and who would have qualified for duty exemption under the relevant provisions thereof, would exceptionally be allowed to take advantage of the benefit provided application is made within six months of the approval of the Recommendations, i.e. not later than 13 August 2014.
- 3. Supervising Officers are requested to make appropriate arrangements for the implementation of the above decision and ensure that the eligible officers are informed forthwith. They should also be informed that application for duty free certificate received after 13 August 2014 will not be entertained.
- 4. It would be appreciated if the contents of this Circular Letter could be brought to the attention of Parastatai and other Statutory Bodies falling under the aegis of your Ministry.
