## Redeployment of employees of ex-Service Providing Institutions of the Sugar Industry

Please refer to this Ministry's Circular Letter No 53 of 2012, wherein you were informed that, in the context of the re-organisation of the former Service Providing Institutions (SPIs) of the Sugar Industry into the Mauritius Cane Industry Authority (MCIA), Government had decided that employees of the former SPIs be redeployed to Ministries/Departments or parastatal organisations.

- 2. On 15 July 2013, this Ministry requested parent Ministries concerned to take appropriate actions for the framing of the relevant schemes of service to accommodate the redeployed employees on the establishment of the parastatal organisations falling under their purview. However, it is noted that several receiving organisations have not yet completed the necessary procedures for the absorption of the redeployed employees on their establishment.
- 3. It is high time to complete the redeployment exercise. Supervising Officers are therefore requested to take necessary actions for the creation or restyling of appropriate posts in the context of the next Budget and the framing of the relevant schemes of service to absorb the redeployed employees on the establishment of their Ministries or that of parastatal bodies falling under the aegis of their Ministry.
