**Australia Awards – Africa Fellowships 2016**

The Australian Government is offering Africa Fellowships in 2016 to African countries, including Mauritius. The Africa Fellowships will normally last between one and three months and the fields of study are as follows:

- Agriculture
- Extractives
- Public Policy

2. The aim of these Australia Awards Fellowships is to foster and strengthen capacity of partner countries, in the areas mentioned above, for mid to senior level professionals.

3. The Australian government will cover the full cost of tuition fees, training materials, accommodation, living expenses, health insurance for basic medical and hospital care in Australia and in Africa, and travel within Africa and to and from Australia. Female candidates and persons with a disability are strongly encouraged to apply.

With a view to better preparing prospective candidates, both for the application and interview exercise, this Ministry will organise an Information Sharing session on **Friday 16 October 2015 at 13:00 hrs at the Lecture Room, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Fooks House, Bourbon Street, Port Louis.** Applicants interested to attend the Information Sharing session are requested to call Mrs J. Before submitting their application, officers should imperatively need to obtain confirmation from their respective Supervising Officer that they would be released on being selected for the Africa Fellowships. Upon selection, Public Officers would be governed by Paragraph 4.10.1 of the Human Resource Management Manual. The closing date for submission of application is Friday 18 December 2015.
