- 2. The objectives of the courses are, inter alia, to familiarize senior public officers with all facets of public sector management in France and Europe. - 3. Public Officers should satisfy the following criteria for admission:-
 - hold a substantive appointment;
 - operate at mid-management level or above;
 - have a minimum of 5 years solid professional experience;
 - have a wide knowledge of the French and European institutions as well as international issues:
 - hold as a minimum a degree at Masters Level; and
 - have an excellent command of French and English language (both spoken and written).

- 4. The selected candidates will be required to enter into a Bond with the Government of Mauritius in accordance with current provisions.
- 5. After successful completion of the training programme, the officers should actively contribute towards the implementation of policies and achievement of organizational objectives. Moreover, the candidate should impart the knowledge and experience acquired to other public officers through training programmes run by this Ministry or other government institutions.
