## Provision of Uniforms

Following the recommendations made at paragraph 9.28 of the Report of the Ad hoc Committee on 'alleged anomalies' arising out of the PRB Reports 1998 and 1999, a Committee has been set up under the chairmanship of the Director. Management Audit Bureau with the following terms of reference:

"To review the provision of uniforms to eligible officers and to make proposals/ recommendations, as appropriate, taking into consideration the following:

- the problems arising out of the supply of uniforms by Management: (a)
- the implications in terms of human resources and its effectiveness: (b)
- the advisability or otherwise for the provision of materials for items of (c) uniforms and for the payment of tailoring fees;
- (d) alternative solutions, e.g. a cash allowance to purchase uniforms of agreed patterns, colour etc; and
- the cost-benefit of different options." (e)
- The Committee, which has already started its exercise, needs information in your organisation as per Annex I in respect of all the grades presently eligible for uniforms. Parastatal Bodies. Local Authorities and those organisations listed at Annex II will not be covered by this
