Launching of the MUDA-free Mauritius Campaign - Phase II

Further to this Ministry's Circular Letter No. 5 of 2002, inviting Ministries/Departments to participate in the sensitization campaign towards a MUDA-free Public Service, the National Productivity and Competitiveness Council is now going ahead with Phase II of the campaign, towards a MUDA-Free Mauritius.

- 2. In this context, the National Productivity and Competitiveness Council has invited Mr. Masaaki Imai, Chairman of the KAIZEN Institute, to launch the campaign. The KAIZEN Institute was established in 1986 to help companies to introduce KAIZEN concepts, systems and tools. The Institute has offices in USA, Europe, Japan, Africa and Asia-Pacific. Mr. Imai has delivered lectures on KAIZEN and Japanese management in Europe, the US, Australia, South Africa, India among other countries. His role has been one of integrating various KAIZEN management practices, such as Just-in-time, TQM and TPM into the cultural environment of organisations.
- 3. The launching of the MUDA-Free Mauritius Campaign Phase II will be held in the Octave Wiehe Auditorium, University of Mauritius, on Monday 1st April, 2002 from 10 00 hours to noon. On this occasion, Mr. Masaaki Imai will deliver a keynote speech.
- 4. It would be appreciated if, subject to the exigencies of the service, officers of your Ministry could be released to attend the function.
