Annual Counter Service Awards Scheme in the Public Service

Please refer to this Ministry's Circular letters No. 24 and 30 of 2003 dated 01 July and 29 July 2003 respectively on the above subject.

- The response from Ministries/Departments has been very positive. 45 entries have been received from Ministries/Departments, including 11 from the Police Department and 12 from the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life by the closing date (i.e. Friday 15 August 2003). The list of participating Ministries/Departments is annexed.
- In accordance with the established guidelines, the evaluation and assessment of the entries will be carried out as follows:

(a) Assessment Visits

Assessment and interview visits will be conducted by a team comprising representatives of the Ministry of Civil Service Affairs and Administrative Reforms, the Mauritian Quality Institute, the Federation of Civil Service Unions, and Government Servants' Association in each participating Ministry/Department during the period September/October 2003. The organisations concerned will be informed beforehand of the date and time of the visits.

(b) Grand Jury

An adjudicating panel acting as the Grand Jury will select the Ministry/ Department for the overall grand prize as well as the other awards. Its composition will be as follows:
