## Issue of Boots/Mini Boots

Approval has been conveyed for the issue of two pairs of boots/mini boots, as an item of protective equipment, to officers in eligible grades every two years. However, representations have been received to the effect that some Ministries/Departments were issuing one pair of boots/mini boots every year instead of two pairs simultaneously for two years.

- The rationale behind the issue of two pairs of boots/mini boots every two years is that eligible officers, whose duties require them to wear this item of protective equipment, need to wash them regularly.
- Moreover, in cases where the protective equipment is damaged before the expiry of the two year period, same should be replaced <u>provided</u> all the stores procedures are followed.
- It would be appreciated if necessary action could be taken at your end.
