Circular Note No 4 of 2003 E/70/2/03/01

To: Supervising Officers-in-Charge of Ministries/Departments

Amendment to Personnel Management Manual

The Personnel Management Manual provides inter alia at:

- (a) Section 1.1.10 that a trainee shall, on enlistment, invariably be required to enter into a bond, in the form set out in Appendix 1D of the Manual; and
- (b) Section 4.10.6 that an officer who is nominated for training, whether locally or overseas, shall be required, before he proceeds on study leave, to enter into a bond, as specified in Appendix 4C of the Manual.
- 2. In view of the difficulties being encountered by certain Ministries/Departments when serving officers and trainees move to other organisations on completion of their training, it has been decided to amend the two pro-forma bonds to provide for the retention of the trainees and the serving officers in the Ministry/Department in which they have been enlisted/where they are posted prior to proceeding on training. Copies of the amended pro-forma bonds are enclosed.
