ICT Training Programme for Public Officers

Would you please refer to this Ministry's Circular Letter No. 34 of 2002, dated 26th September 2002 (copy is enclosed for easy reference).

- 2. As at to-date, some 2,400 officers of the General Services have already completed their ICT Training Programme for Public Officers out of 3,000 largetted. The programme is scheduled to end by August this year. The blowing categories of officers of the General Services <u>inter alia</u> are being tained, under the ICT Training Programme:
