Appointment of Public Officers to inquire into disciplinary cases

The Public Service Commission is preparing a list of public officers who may be appointed to inquire into disciplinary cases under regulation 37 of the Public Service Commission Regulations and under regulation 35 or regulation 36 of the Disciplined Forces Service Commission Regulations as and when required.

In this context, it would be appreciated if you would kindly submit by <u>17 January 2005</u> at latest a list of public officers who are drawing salary in a scale the minimum of which is not less than Rs 22,400 and who are willing to be considered for appointment to inquire into distiplinary cases under the abovementioned regulations.
