Contents of Circulars

The attention of this Ministry has been drawn to the fact that officers in certain Ministries and Departments are not informed of the contents of circulars.

- 2. Supervising Officers should ensure that the contents of all circulars, especially vacancy circulars, should invariably be brought to the attention of <u>all</u> officers concerned, including those who are on approved leave. In case of officers who are overseas, a copy of the Circular Note together with application forms should be despatched to them on the very day on which these Circular Notes are issued.
- Ministries/Departments are also requested to advise parastatal bodies falling under their purview accordingly.
