The Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues and Outer Islands has been asked by way of Parliamentary Question B 267

“Whether he is aware if there are persons in the public sector earning Rs 150,000 or above monthly, and if so, will he (a) table a list thereof (b) give a breakdown of the other fringe benefits to which they are entitled and (c) state if the salary and allowances are paid in foreign currency?”
