Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP), Singapore

The Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP) at the National University of Singapore (NUS) is offering two scholarships for the Master's in Public Administration Programme (MPA).

3. Applications are invited from among Officers of the Administrative Cadre who have:


- (i) a Bachelor's Degree or an equivalent qualification from a recognized University;
- (ii) a very good knowledge of English (both spoken and written); and
- (iii) at least five years of work experience.

4. The selected candidates will be required to enter into a bond in accordance with the provisions of the Personnel Management Manual. After successful completion of the programme, they should actively contribute towards the implementation of government policies and the achievement of organizational objectives. They should also be prepared to impart the newly acquired knowledge and expertise among officers by serving as Resource Persons in Public Management Courses.

Interested officers should submit their applications in duplicate on the enclosed Application Form. They should send one application directly to the Human Resource Development Division of this Ministry, 3rd Floor, Atom House, Royal Road, Port Louis by Friday 21 December 2007 at latest and transmit the second application through their respective Supervising Officer.
