## Parliamentary Questions

It would be appreciated if you would kindly submit to this Ministry, at latest by 1630 hours today, information on the following Parliamentary Questions:

- Whether, in regard to the advisers and press attachés recruited by Government since April 2006 todate, either on a full time or part time basis, he will now state their respective (a) names (b) qualifications (c) salaries, allowances and other benefits drawn and (d) conditions of service?
- Whether, in regard to persons presently employed in the public service and earning between Rs 100,000 and Rs 150,000 monthly, he will give a list thereof, together with a breakdown of the fringe benefits to which they are entitled, indicating if their salaries or allowances are paid in foreign currencies?
- Whether, in regard to persons who are over 60 years of age and who are in employment in the public service, he will state the number thereof?
- Nil return should also be submitted.
