## Vacancy at the Commonwealth Secretariat

The Commonwealth Secretariat is inviting nominations for the post of Adviser and Head of Section, Small States, Environment and Economic Management Section, Economic Affairs Division.

- Applicants should, among others, have:
  - a Post-Graduate degree in Economics or Sustainable Development and 10 years of related work experience;
  - (ii) a proven track record of at least 10 years work experience at a policy level, dealing with issues concerning small states and sustainable development; and
  - (iii) demonstrated experience managing interdisciplinary teams.

- Applicants should note that:
  - they should provide their curriculum vitae listing three referees accompanied by a covering letter setting out their experience and skills in relation to the competencies and other requirements for the post;

- (b) they should complete the monitoring form available on the website of the secretariat and return it with their application;
- (c) they should be nationals of a Commonwealth country;
- it is the Commonwealth Secretariat's policy not to employ close relatives of current members of staff;
- (e) all appointments are subject to three satisfactory references, one of whom should be their current or most recent employer and one from their employer prior to that; and
- (f) salary on appointment is £ 40,465 per annum.
- Bearing in mind the importance of improving the representation of appropriately qualified women at senior levels in the Secretariat, women are encouraged to apply.
- Interested candidates are requested to forward their applications for the above post directly to the Commonwealth Secretariat by <u>Thursday 30 July 2009 at latest</u>.
