Review of Monetary Ceilings for the purchase of Official Cars

The High Powered Committee, at its meeting of 27 June 2013, has decided that the monetary ceilings for the purchase of official cars be revised as follows:

Officers drawing a monthly salary of Rs 95000 in position of Accounting/Responsible Officer	850,000	900,000
Officers drawing salary of Rs 102,000 and up to Rs 111,000	1,070,000	1,130,000
Officers drawing salary of more than Rs 111,000 and up to Rs 114,000	1,070,000	1,220,000
Officers drawing a monthly salary of above Rs 114,000 and up to	1,420,000	1,500,000
Rs 144,000 as well as the Deputy Master and Registrar and Judge in Bankruptcy		
Officers drawing a monthly salary of more than Rs 144,000	1,700,000	1,800,000
