**Residential Summer School 2014:**  
**Governance for Development in Africa Initiative**

The Mo Ibrahim Foundation, in association with the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) and the Centre of African Studies of the University of London, is inviting participation for a 'Residential Summer School on Governance for Development in Africa Initiative' to be held in Mauritius from 31 March to 04 April 2014.

2. The residential school targets twenty participants who are policy makers, academics, researchers or civil society representatives. Participants will gain new ideas and knowledge on the broad issue of governance and development.
3. Applicants should have at least a Master degree in areas related to Governance or five years professional experience in fields relevant to the theme of Governance and Development in Africa.
4. All costs will be borne by the Mo Ibrahim Foundation.

  - (i) CV (including email address for correspondence);
  - (ii) one reference letter (or names of referees in CV); and
  - (iii) proposal (maximum of 1500 words) outlining research interest and professional background and explaining how the applicant would benefit from attending the Summer School.
