EOAC Report 2013 - Representations

In the wake of representations received following the publication of the Report of the Errors, Omissions and Anomalies Committee 2013, Government has decided to set up a committee to consider the representations and make recommendations.

- 2. The Committee will be chaired by the Senior Chief Executive of this Ministry and would comprise as members representatives of
 - (a) the Prime Minister's Office;
 - (b) the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development; and
 - (c) the Pay Research Bureau.
- 3. The Committee proposes to finalise this exercise as soon as possible. It will therefore complete compilation of representations by 15 August 2013 to enable the examination of all representations received and make appropriate recommendations to Government.
- 4. It should be noted that only issues arising out of the EOAC Report may be considered by this Committee. No new issues will be attended to.
