Request for 70% Excise Duty Remission on a motor car by retired Public Officers

The High Powered Committee, at its meeting of 29 August 2013, has approved that officers who qualified for 70% duty remission for the purchase of a car under paragraph 18.2.23 (i) of the EOAC Report 2013 and who had retired between 01 January 2013 and the date of the publication of the EOAC Report 2013 be exceptionally allowed to take advantage of the 70% duty remission.

- As government decision for the implementation of the recommendations of the EOAC Report 2013 was conveyed by way of this Ministry's Circular Note No. 26 of 2013 dated 30 May 2013, it has been decided that officers retiring between January 2013 up to 30 June 2013 who were not eligible under the PRB Report 2013 for 70% duty remission but qualified for same under the EOAC Report 2013, be allowed to take advantage of the 70% duty remission. In line with current regulations, the officers concerned will be given a delay of six months as from the date they obtain the duty free certificate to take advantage of the 70% duty remission.
- Supervising Officers are requested to make appropriate arrangements for the implementation of the above decision and ensure that the eligible retired officers are informed forthwith. They should also be informed that application for duty free certificate received after 28 February 2014 will not be entertained.
- It would be appreciated if the contents of this Circular Letter could be brought to the attention of Parastatal and other Statutory Bodies falling under the aegis of your respective Ministry.
