**Purchase of a duty exempted car of higher  
engine capacity**

The High Powered Committee has, at its meeting held on 14 December 2021, agreed that the provision at paragraph 16.2.19 of the 2021 PRB Report be replaced by the provision at paragraph 18.2.17 (d) of the 2016 PRB Report, which reads as follow “we recommend that an officer eligible for duty exemption may be allowed to purchase a car of higher engine capacity than his normal entitlement subject to a maximum of 2250 cc provided he pays the difference in the excise duty”.

2. Supervising Officers are hereby requested to bring the content of this Circular to the attention of all officers concerned of their Ministries/Departments and Head of Parastatal Bodies and Local Authorities falling under the aegis of their respective Ministries/Departments.
