AARDO - SIET Partial Scholarship in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, India

The African-Asian Rural Development Organisation (AARDO) and the Shobhit Institute of Engineering and Technology (SIET) are inviting applications for partial scholarship opportunities to qualified officers to pursue courses which will start in August 2024 at the SIET in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, India, as follows –

SN	Courses	Duration
(i)	Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)	Three years full time
(ii)	Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech)	Four Years full time
(iii)	Master of Technology (M.Tech)	Two Year full time
(iv)	Master of Business Administration (MBA)	Two Year full time

2. The Scholarship offered under this programme will cover 50% waiver on the total tuition fees and hostel fees up to an upper ceiling of Indian Rupees 20, 000/- (approximately US \$250 each year) only for the period of study (2/4 years as applicable). The cost of both-way air tickets will have to be met by the nominee, except for five (5) candidates who will be sponsored by AARDO, based on the merit list to be provided by the Selection Committee of Shobhit University. The General Guide is at Annex.

3. Interested candidates should -

- (a) seek clearance as mentioned at paragraph 5 below and, thereafter, submit their applications electronically through the website: <https://www.shobhituniversity.ac.in/shobhit-aardo-scholarship-form.php> . The closing date for submission of online application is **Friday 02 August 2024**; and

(b) submit, through their respective Supervising Officers, the duly filled in documents listed below to the Human Resource Development Division of this Ministry, (attention Mrs A. Luchmun) by **Friday 14 June 2024** –

- (i) Survey and Undertaking forms (original and 1 copy);
- (ii) Print out of the duly filled in Application form (3 copies);
- (iii) Copies of educational and professional qualifications (Degree certificate and Mark Sheets) (3 copies);
- (iv) Copy of passport and Birth Certificate (3 copies);
- (v) Curriculum Vitae (3 copies);
- (vi) Statement of Purpose (800-1000 words) (3 copies).
- (vii) Two letters of Reference (3 copies);
- (viii) Proof of Language Proficiency (3 copies);
- (ix) Medical Certificate and x-ray reports (original and 2 copies);
- (x) 3 Photo (Passport Size); and
- (xi) Any other documents as requested by the organisers (3 copies).


4. All necessary clearances, as appropriate, should be sought by the nominating Ministry/Department, and the procedures set out in this Ministry's Circular Letter No 41 of 27 September 2016 should be strictly complied with. **Applications received after the closing date set by this Ministry or incomplete applications will not be processed.**

5. In view of the fact that **nominations for any of the programmes are subject to exigencies of the service, applicants should imperatively seek and obtain approval from their respective Responsible Officers that they would be released in the event they are awarded the scholarship.** The conditions for the release of an officer are as follows:-

- (a) an officer shall be eligible for study leave with pay in accordance with paragraph 16.4.81 of the PRB Report 2021, where he is nominated for an open scholarship which is considered as in-service training and the course is a priority field of study;
- (b) where an officer is granted study leave with pay, he will be required to enter into a bond with the Government of Mauritius in accordance with the provisions laid down in this Ministry's Circular Letter No. 1 of 2022; and
- (c) where the officer does not satisfy the conditions for the grant of study leave with pay, he may take advantage of leave without pay for study purposes in accordance with paragraph 16.4.94 (G) of the PRB Report 2021.

6. For all overseas (face to face) training, the conditions imposed by the Ministry of Health and Wellness and highlighted in this Ministry's Circular Letter No. 50 of 2021, should be strictly observed.

7. You are requested to ensure that the contents of this Circular Letter be brought to the attention of all eligible public officers serving in your Ministry/Department, including those in Local Authorities, Statutory Bodies and State-Owned enterprises falling under the purview of your Ministry/Department.

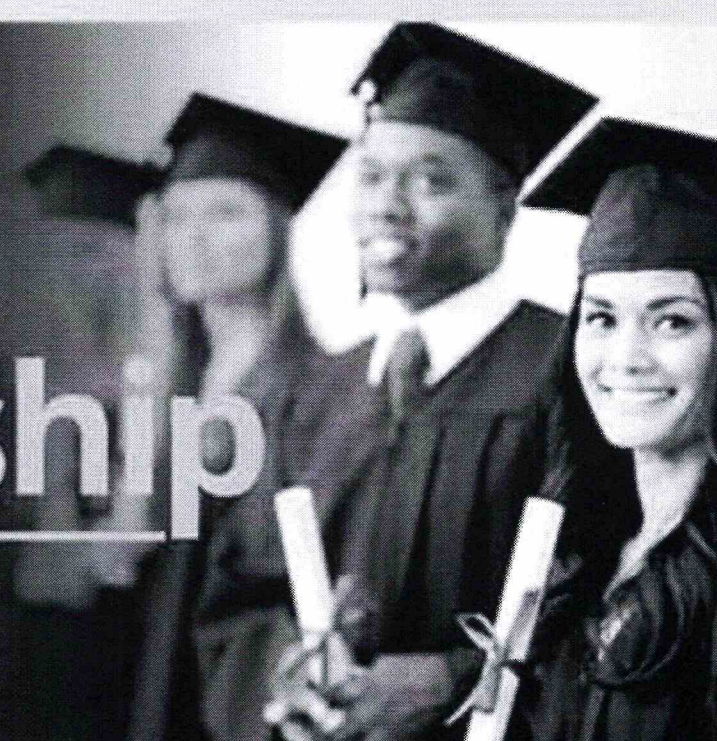

Eligibility

Minimum qualifications:

B.Sc. Agriculture Honors – Bachelor of Science (4 Years)

Admission to B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture Programs is open to candidates who have Passed (10+2) / Intermediate / Higher Secondary from any approved Board with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics / Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Agriculture.

B.Tech. -Bachelor of Technology (4 Years)

Admission to B.Tech. Programs is open to a student who passed / appeared Intermediate / Higher Secondary (10+2) from any approved Board with minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics /Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.

M.Tech. –Master of Technology (2 Years)

Admission to M. Tech Programs is open to a student who passed B.Tech. or an equivalent degree in the

allied branch of Engineering with a minimum of 55% marks from a recognized University or MCA or M.Sc. degree in a related branch with 60% or higher aggregate marks from a recognized University.

MBA – Master of Business Administration (2 Years)

Admission to MBA Program is open to candidates who have passed a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in any discipline from a recognized university with at least 50% aggregate marks.

Please note:

- Foreign nationals with an eligible degree from Indian Universities will be treated on par with Indian nationals for admission.
- Foreign nationals with foreign degrees must meet the minimum educational requirements equivalent to an Indian Master's degree in the relevant disciplines.
- Foreign students are expected to have a working knowledge of English.
- If the medium of instruction for their qualifying degree was not English, applicants must produce proof of proficiency in English - IELTS with a minimum score of 6.5 (overall) or a TOEFL score of 80 (overall). Test results should be dated no earlier than 15 September 2019.
- Foreign nationals can only register as full-time scholars.
- All the applicants should have a good academic record.
- The Selection Committees may set higher evaluation criteria than the minimum eligibility criteria listed.
- The selection, admission, and award of the Bachelor/Master degree shall be governed by the ordinances of the senate of Shobhit University.

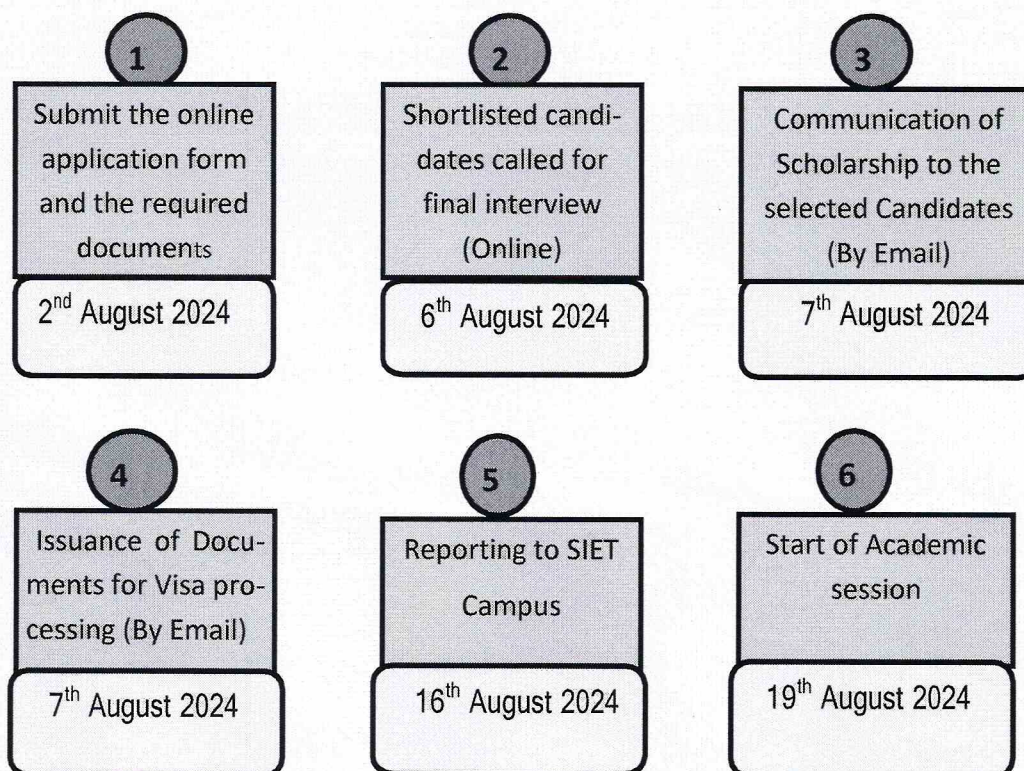

- Documents submitted in a foreign language should be accompanied by a full English language translation. The translation should be certified by the translator and bear their certification credentials
- If you have a long-term health condition, disability, specific learning difficulty or mental health condition we encourage you to disclose this in your application with any relevant information.

Applications are invited through the AARDO and SIET Partial Scholarships. All candidates seeking admission to the program must submit their initial application in a prescribed form along with attested copies of relevant testimonials in the website <https://www.shobhituniversity.ac.in/shobhit-aardo-scholarship-form.php> of the University as per the following timeline.



TIMELINE OF SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

Selected candidates shall be enrolled for the program only after submitting medical fitness certificate and after arrival at SIET campus they need to undergo medical fitness.

Scholarship Details

Students selected to AARDO and the SIET Scholarship will be offered the following

- 50% waiver on the total tuition fees
- Hostel charges up to an upper ceiling of Rs. 20,000/- (approximately US \$250 each year) only for the period of study (2/4 years as applicable).
- Both way air-tickets, sponsored by AARDO, for joining in and on successful completion of the programme, only for the five candidates on the merit list to be provided by the selection committee of Shobhit University.
