## **Invitation to the Strong Nations for Africa Programme**

The Chandler Institute of Governance (CIG) and the African Association for Public Administration and Management (AAPAM) are jointly inviting participation in the *Strong Nations for Africa Programme 2024*.

- 2. The Strong Nations for Africa Programme is a senior management programme designed for senior African public sector leaders to support them for building strong nations for the next generation. The applicant's profile are as follows:
  - (i) should be a citizen of an African country;
  - (ii) currently living and working in the public service of an African country;
  - (iii) have a minimum of 5 years' experience working in the public service;
  - (iv) be fluent in English; and
  - (v) be present and commit to participate in all segments and activities of the programme.
- 3. The programme will be delivered through two residential segments which will be held in South Africa and Singapore and through a mix of modalities as follows:
  - Residential Segment in South Africa: 29 July to 2 August 2024
  - Online Segment: 12 to 16 August 2024
  - Residential Segment in Singapore: 26 to 30 August 2024
- 4. CIG will offer a limited number of scholarships to selected programme participants who demonstrate a strong track record of leadership and a commitment to improving national governance in their respective countries. Scholarships award will be done in consultation with an eminent panel of former government practitioners, experts and senior public sector leaders.
- 5. Participants will be required to cover their own costs of travel, accommodation and expenses as well as a registration fee of US\$1,000/-. However, for those who will receive a scholarship, some financial support towards the travel expenses of the participants will be provided.
