The Secretary of the United Nations is inviting nominations for the 2026 United Nations Public Service Awards (UNPSA).

- 2. The objective of the UNPSA is to recognise efforts that advance effective, transparent, accountable, innovative and inclusive public governance, administration and services for sustainable development, in line with Sustainable Development Goal 16.
- 3. The 2026 UNPSA is open for nominations in the following categories:
 - (i) Category 1 Delivering inclusive and equitable services to leave no one behind
 - (ii) Category 2 Gender-responsive public services
 - (iii) Category 3 -Transparent and accountable public institutions to achieve the SDGs
 - (iv) Category 4- Participation and public engagement for inclusive decision-making
- 4. The Award is open to all public sector institutions at national, state and local levels from all UN member states.
