## **Uniform Allowances for Drivers**

Please refer to this Ministry's Circular Letter No. 75 of 19 December 2024.

- 2. As you are aware, the Standing Committee on Uniforms had approved that Drivers (Ordinary vehicles up to 5 tonnes), Drivers (on shift), Drivers (on roster), Drivers (on roster day and night), Drivers (Heavy vehicles above 5 tonnes) and Drivers, Mechanical Unit be paid Uniform Allowance under Category 1 and that they should mandatorily wear, amongst others, "a white shirt", as from Monday 03 March 2025.
- 3. Following representations received regarding the above, and further consultations with the Union/Federation concerned, the Standing Committee has, exceptionally, agreed that, for practical reasons, grades who are required to drive off-road, be allowed to wear <u>dark grey polo shirts (either short or long sleeves)</u> as follows:-
  - (i) Drivers (Heavy vehicles above 5 tonnes);
  - (ii) Drivers, Mechanical Unit; and
  - (iii) Drivers (Ordinary vehicles up to 5 tonnes).
- 4. However, the grey polo shirts should be within the approved quantum of allowance and whenever these Drivers drive on normal roads, they should wear the recommended **white shirts**.
- 5. Supervising Officers are requested to bring the contents of this Circular Letter to the attention of all those concerned and ensure strict compliance therewith.
