Collaboration Between the Ministry of Public Service and Administrative Reforms and the University of Technology, Mauritius

The collaboration of this Ministry has been sought by a Senior Lecturer at the University of Technology, Mauritius (UTM) to disseminate a survey questionnaire to Women Leaders in the Public Service in the wake of a research project being undertaken on the theme "Transition of women to senior leadership positions".
