**World Day for Safety and Health at Work 2026**

The World Day for Safety and Health at Work is celebrated yearly on 28 April to raise awareness on the importance of occupational safety and health worldwide based on a specific theme.

2. For this year's celebration, the theme chosen by the International Labour Organization (ILO) for this year's celebration is **"Let's Ensure a Healthy Psychosocial Working Environment"** and will focus on the psychosocial working environment, defined by how work is designed, organised and managed, and the organisational practices that shape everyday working conditions.

3. To mark the World Day for Safety and Health at Work 2026, this Ministry is organising a Workshop on **Tuesday 28 April 2026**, from 08 45 to 14:00 hours at the **Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Public Service and Innovation, Réduit (Minissy), Moka**.

4. The Workshop will be an opportunity to:

- (i). raise awareness among participants on psychosocial risks in the workplace and their impact on employee well-being, productivity, and organisational performance;
- (ii). enhance knowledge of preventive strategies, policies, and good practices to manage psychosocial risks effectively;
- (iii). build capacity of Chairpersons of Safety and Health Committees and Safety and Health Cadre officers to identify, assess, and address psychosocial hazards within their Ministries and Departments; and
- (iv). promote a culture of prevention and well-being, reinforcing the principles of a healthy psychosocial working environment across the Public Service.
