**Release of Public Officers for overseas training**

Please refer to this Ministry's Circular Note No. 6 of 2020 wherein Supervising Officers were advised to refrain from sending Public Officers on training courses to countries affected by the Coronavirus.

2. The Ministry of Health and Wellness has, now, informed that public officers may be released to proceed abroad for official training, subject to:

- (i) strict adherence to the sanitary protocol prevalent in the country they are proceeding to;
- (ii) the officers being fully vaccinated by a vaccine recognized in the host country;
- (iii) the officers being covered by a travelling medical insurance which relates to Covid 19; and
- (iv) compliance with the prevailing sanitary guidelines and protocols issued by the Ministry of Health and Wellness for returning Mauritians/Residents

3. Supervising Officers should ensure that, henceforth, nominations for overseas Training / Seminars / Workshops / Study Tours satisfy the conditions laid by the Ministry of Health and Wellness.

4. It would be appreciated if the contents of this Circular could be brought to the attention of all those concerned, including parastatal bodies falling under the purview of your Ministry/Department.
