COVID-19: Arrangements for officers proceeding on Tour of Service

As you are aware, in accordance with existing terms and conditions, public officers domiciled in Mauritius may be required to serve on a tour of service in Rodrigues and the Outer Islands.

- 2. Given the prevailing COVID-19 situation in Mauritius, it has been decided that special arrangements should be made well in advance to enable those officers to proceed to Rodrigues and the Outer Islands in the best possible conditions with respect to the sanitary protocol put in place.
- 3. In this connection, Supervising Officers are requested to communicate to this Ministry the particulars of officers who have been scheduled to proceed to Rodrigues and/or the Outer Islands during the coming three months, to serve on a tour of service, indicating their expected date of departure, so that appropriate arrangements be made with the Ministry of Health and Wellness for them to serve their mandatory quarantine of 14 days period just before their planned departure.
