Qualifications: By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of an officer in the grade of Senior Scientific Officer (Conservation) who reckons at least four years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade and who –

- (i) has managerial and leadership capabilities;
(ii) possesses good communication skills; and
(iii) has the ability to interact with people at all levels.

Role and Responsibilities: To assist in the implementation of programs and policies related to Native Terrestrial Biodiversity Conservation and in the effective and efficient management of the National Parks and Conservation Service.

- Duties: 1. To deputise for the Director, National Parks and Conservation Service, as and when required.
2. To assist the Director, National Parks and Conservation Service in –
(i) the general administration and management of the National Parks and Conservation Service;
(ii) all matters relating to the in-situ and ex-situ conservation of endemic fauna and flora;
(iii) the management of reserves/parks;
(iv) matters of human resources and capacity building of the National Parks and Conservation Service including training of staff;
(v) identifying and developing conservation projects and providing advice on the formulation of policies and legislation relating to wildlife conservation and reserves/parks management; and
