Qualifications:

By selection from among serving employees on the permanent and pensionable establishment who reckon at least eight years' service and who –

- (a) possess the Certificate of Primary Education or the Primary School Achievement Certificate; and
- (b) have practical knowledge of mechanics and electricity or electronics.

NOTE 1

In the absence of candidates possessing the qualification at (a) above, consideration will be given to those who show proof of being literate.

NOTE 2

Selected candidates will be appointed in a temporary capacity in the first instance and will be required to undergo on-the-job training in all aspects of the work of an Incinerator Operator for a period of at least six months as approved and arranged by the Ministry. On satisfactory completion of the training and on being favourably reported upon, they will be considered for appointment as Incinerator Operator in a substantive capacity.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Duties:

- 1. To be responsible to the Agricultural Superintendent or Agricultural Support Officer/Senior Agricultural Support Officer for
 - (a) the operation of the incinerator and associated equipment according to operating instructions and safety norms in connection with
 - (i) the destruction of pantry refuse from aircrafts or vessels and other materials as directed;

- (ii) the destruction of animal carcasses after post-mortem analysis, imported meat discarded after necessary tests, media after performing cultures and other materials as directed; and
- (iii) incineration of waste from the laboratory.
- (b) the day-to-day maintenance of the incinerator plant and related equipment including minor repairs and servicing;
- (c) the record of waste incinerated;
- (d) the segregation of waste; and
- (e) the removal of ashes from the incinerator and premises after each operation.
- 2. To carry out regular checks and report immediately any fault or breakdown to the Agricultural Superintendent and the Agricultural Support Officer/Senior Agricultural Support Officer.
- 3. To keep the incinerator and its environment clean and tidy at all times.
- 4. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Incinerator Operator in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Incinerator Operators will be required to work outside normal working hours including Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.
