**Post:** Aerodrome Licensing Officer

**Salary:** Rs 17,270 x 600 - 21,470 (CIA 14A)

**Effective Date:** 28 October 2002

**Qualifications:** By selection from among officers in the grade of Air Traffic Control Supervisor who:

- (i) have knowledge of national and international requirements relating to the types of aerodromes; and
- (ii) are familiar with relevant International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) documents.

Candidates should produce written evidence of all knowledge claimed.

- Duties:**
1. To inspect aerodromes at regular intervals in order to assess the extent to which they satisfy national and international requirements.
  2. To monitor the standards of aerodrome operations and practices.
  3. To ensure that aerodrome staff are performing in accordance with required standards.
  4. To carry out investigation as directed.
  5. To report shortcomings, make appropriate recommendations and carry out follow-up actions.
  6. To make recommendations regarding the licensing of aerodromes.
  7. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

1. Aerodrome Licensing Officers may be required to work outside normal working hours including Sundays, Public Holidays and officially declared cyclone days and during emergencies.
2. They may be required to follow such theoretical or practical training courses, locally or overseas as may be approved and arranged.
3. They may be sent on assignment to Rodrigues or any of the Outer Islands of the Republic of Mauritius.
