- Effective Date:** 6 December 2006
- Age Limit:** Between 18 and 26 years
- Qualifications:**
- A. (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings or
- (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or
- (c) An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level” or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above.

NOTE

For the first intake, consideration will be given to officers who hold a substantive appointment in the grades of Patrolman or Aviation Patrolman, possess qualifications at A and B above and are conversant with the provisions of Annex 17 (Security) and Annex 9 (Facilitation) to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, although they are above 26 years of age.

Training:

Trainee Aviation Security/Facilitation Officers will be required to undergo on-the-job training, both theoretical and practical, in all aspects of aviation security and air transport facilitation for a period of at least twelve months. On successful completion of the training, they will be considered for appointment to the grade of Aviation Security/Facilitation Officer, as and when vacancies occur.

Note

Trainee Aviation Security/Facilitation Officers will be required to work outside normal working hours, on Sundays, Public Holidays and officially declared cyclone days and during emergencies.
