Qualifications:

- A. A Cambridge School Certificate or Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.
- B. The National Trade Certificate (Level 2) in Automotive Mechanics and Electronics or the National Certificate (Level 4) in Automotive Mechanics and Electronics awarded by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

- C. Candidates should –
 - (i) reckon at least two years’ experience in the repair of electronics equipment, preferably in Automobile Electronics System.
 - (ii) be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed.

Duties:

- 1. To troubleshoot, test and repair or renew electronic engine components/devices such as sensors, actuators, Electronic Component Mechanism (ECM), ignition system and fuel injection system.
- 2. To diagnose, test and repair or renew electronic component, control module incorporated in mechanical/electronics systems found on vehicles such as ABS control module, instrumentation, lighting system, starters, alternators and airbag control module.
