- (i) be registered as Professional Engineer of Mauritius in the relevant field of Mechanical/Automobile/Mechatronics/Building Services Engineering with the Council of Registered Professional Engineers of Mauritius under Section 13 of the Registered Professional Engineers Council Act No. 49 of 1965, as subsequently amended; and
- (ii) be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

- Duties:**
1. To execute engineering works relating to mechanical, automobile and building services, as may be required.
 2. To guide, supervise and coordinate the work of subordinate staff of the Mechanical Engineering Section.
 3. To be responsible for the day-to-day running of the specific divisions within the Section.
 4. To coordinate his activities with those of other divisions in the Mechanical Engineering Section.
 5. To coach and guide Trainee Engineers posted to the Section in their professional training.
 6. To examine Government vehicles involved in accidents and to attend court in connection therewith.
 7. To give technical advice to Government institutions, including the National Transport Authority and to provide guidance to the subordinate technical staff of the latter Authority, whenever required.
