- Post:** Plumber and Pipe Fitter
- Salary:** Rs 13,010 x 260 – 14,050 x 275 – 15,150 x 300 – 15,750 x 325 – 17,700 x 375 – 19,575 x 475 – 21,950 x 625 – 23,200 x 775 – 23,975 (25 023 052)
- Effective Date:** 22 May 2017
- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of employees who hold a substantive appointment in the grade of Tradesman's Assistant in the Ministry and who have passed the appropriate trade test.
- Duties:**
1. To carry out necessary measurements and calculations of the trade in accordance with technical specifications.
  2. To connect water system from meter to buildings and execute necessary reductions, connections and branches.
  3. To install baths, cistern, syphons and overflow, urinals, water taps, water pumps and to connect them to water supply.
  4. To identify all the fittings and fittings materials used in plumbing and make appropriate connections.
  5. To lay pipes (galvanised, PVC and other types) for hot and cold water system.
  6. To cut pipes and adjust for proper connections.
  7. To make a leak test on all connections and repair any leak.
  8. To undertake all types of maintenance work related to hot and cold water system.
  9. To identify and use proper glue material for respective pipe and fittings.
  10. To prepare estimates in regard to types and quantities of materials required for specific plumbing and pipe fitting works.

11. To read scale plans, take off dimensions and set out any domestic or industrial connections and sewer.
12. To advise on the use and purchase of materials, tools and equipment of the trade.
13. To follow all safety guidelines when using specific tools and equipment of the trade.
14. To use and maintain in good condition, all tools, equipment and accessories of the trade.
15. To train and guide Tradesman's Assistants engaged in the same trade and other workers under his supervision.
16. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Plumber and Pipe Fitter in the roles ascribed to him.
