Qualifications: By selection from amongst employees of the Ministry who

(a) possess the Cambridge School Certificate or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission;

(b) have a knowledge in theory and practice of and are able to demonstrate in the following talas (Measures):-

Keharwa, Dadra, Trital, Jhabtal, Ektal, Chautal, Tilwara, Jhumra and Punjabi.

In the absence of candidates possessing the qualifications at (a) above, consideration will be given to candidates who qualify at (b) above provided they have some knowledge of English, French and any oriental language.

Note:

For the first intake preference will be given to candidates who have at least three years' experience in providing accompaniment on "tabla" in music and dance classes, music concerts and dance performances although they do not possess the qualifications mentioned at (a) above provided they have some knowledge of English, French and any oriental language.

Duties:

1. To demonstrate in the following talas (Measures):-

Keharwa, Dadra, Trital, Jhabtal, Ektal, Chautal, Tilwara, Jhumra, Punjabi

2. To accompany music lessons in group singing and to take part in School concerts, National Festivals.

3. To help in the teaching of Indian music (Tabla) as required by the Ministry.

4. To provide accompaniment in music concerts, music and dance classes.

5. To help in the organisation of music concerts and dance performances put up by the Ministry.

6. To perform other cognate duties.
