- Ministry:** National Infrastructure and Community Development (Energy Services Division)
- Post:** Chief Plant Mechanic (on shift)
- Salary:** Rs 21,850 x 375 – 22,225 x 400 – 23,425 x 525 – 26,050 x 675 – 27,400 x 825 – 35,650 x 900 – 37,450 (25 047 070)
- Effective Date:** 09 November 2023
- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of employees in the grade of Plant Mechanic (on shift) who reckon at least eight years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade or an aggregate of at least eight years' service in a substantive capacity in the grades of Plant Mechanic and Plant Mechanic (on shift) and who –
- (i) possess the Certificate of Primary Education or the Primary School Achievement Certificate; and
 - (ii) possess supervisory skills.

NOTE 1

In the absence of employees in the grade of Plant Mechanic (on shift) possessing the qualification at (i) above, consideration will be given to those who show proof of being literate.

NOTE 2

For the first intake, by appointment of Chief Plant Mechanics on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Ministry who have opted for the revised emoluments and terms and conditions set out in the Pay Research Bureau Report 2021 and who opt to join the grade of Chief Plant Mechanic (on shift).

- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Electrical Engineer/Senior Electrical Engineer, Energy Services Division through the Principal Technician, Energy Services Division or the Senior Technician, Energy Services Division and to take charge of all works and equipment under his responsibility.
 2. To organise and supervise the work of a team of Plant Mechanics (on shift).
 3. To exercise control over subordinate staff, promote discipline and report grievances to superior officers.

4. To assist in the preparation of estimates and costs sheet.
5. To supervise the quality and the quantity of work performed by staff under his responsibility.
6. To keep an inventory of loose tools issued to staff.
7. To requisite materials from substores and keep control over their use.
8. To prepare time sheets and keep time books on sites, where required.
9. To perform the duties of a Plant Mechanic (on shift), as and when required, especially the complex cases.
10. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Chief Plant Mechanic (on shift) in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Chief Plant Mechanics (on shift) will be required to work on shift covering a 24-hour service including Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays and during cyclonic periods and natural calamities.
