Training:

The Trainee Engineer (Electrical) will be required to undergo or complete a period of training not exceeding three years, during which he must have been registered as a Professional Engineer by the Council of Registered Professional Engineers of Mauritius failing which his enlistment will be terminated.

During the training period, the Trainee Engineer (Electrical) will work under the direct responsibility and supervision of the Principal Engineer (Electrical Services Division) and will not be allowed to decide or advise or report on, design or approve the designs of any engineering projects.

NOTE

Successful completion of the training will not give the Trainees any claim to appointment in the Ministry. However, upon registration as Professional Engineers, Trainees will be considered for appointment as Electrical Engineer (Electrical Services Division) provided vacancies exist and subject to their suitability based *inter alia* on their performance and conduct during the period of training.
