- (ii) have a knowledge of First Aid.

Duties:

- 1. To work from plans and sketches and carry out the necessary measurements and calculations of the trade.
- 2. To identify the timbers used in the trade on the basis of their particularities with regard to grain directions.
- 3. To operate in an efficient manner all of the following: circular saws, band saws, planning and thicknessing machines, mortising machines and tenoning machines.
- 4. To mark off and cut any given timbers accurately to a specified size and to best advantage.
- 5. To remove and reset all cutters in any machine and to sharpen saws used in the trade.
- 6. To prepare estimates for materials, labour and time required to execute works.
- 7. To carry out works related to maintenance and repairs works before and after cyclones, flooding and other national disasters.
- 8. To make use of appropriate powered tools for the execution of works and to ensure good housekeeping of all tools generally used in the trade and the workplace.
- 9. To comply with safety and health standards.
- 10. To train and guide other workers under his supervision.
- 11. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Wood Machinist in the roles ascribed to him.
