- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Principal Fisheries Officer reckoning at least two years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade and having:
- (i) sound administrative and managerial abilities;
 - (ii) good communication and interpersonal skills;
 - (iii) leadership skills; and
 - (iv) wide knowledge in fisheries research and development.
- Role and Responsibilities:** To provide overall leadership, co-ordination and technical advice on fisheries administration and management.
- Duties:**
- I. To advise on –
 - (i) all matters connected with fisheries management and conservation of all aquatic living resources and the marine environment;
 - (ii) the framing of appropriate fisheries legislation in line with Government policies for the fisheries and marine conservation sectors;
 - (iii) the introduction of new technology needed for the development of fisheries resources; and
 - (iv) all matters relating to bilateral, regional and international fisheries organisations.

2. To be responsible for –
 - (i) the smooth running of the fisheries research, development and protection services;
 - (ii) the administration of the One Stop Shop Sea Food Hub; and
 - (iii) the proper staffing of the various Technical Divisions and to ensure that human resources are being utilised in the most efficient and effective manner.
3. To provide necessary support to the development of land-based oceanic industry.
4. To ensure –
 - (i) the timely execution of Government policies and projects; and
 - (ii) the monitoring of all fishing activities and advise on their control and surveillance.
5. To promote sustainable development of fisheries and aquaculture.
6. To devise appropriate training programmes for the staff and stakeholders in the fishing industry.
7. To advise on matters, and take part in negotiations whenever required, relating to fisheries agreements with foreign countries, intergovernmental or fisheries organisations.
8. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
9. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Director of Fisheries in the roles ascribed to him.
