- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Home Economics Officer who reckon at least three years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade.
- Duties:**
1. To assist the Head, Home Economics Unit in –
    - (a) the planning, organisation, supervision and co-ordination of the work of Home Economics Officers and others officers working in the Unit;
    - (b) the co-ordination of the various activities of the Home Economics programme and the evaluation thereof;
    - (c) the training of Home Economics Officers and other junior staff;
    - (d) the organisation of conferences, seminars, exhibitions, competitions and other activities aimed at improving the quality of life of the population;
    - (e) the production and development of Information, Educational & Communication (IEC) materials in connection with the various Home Economics programme as required for the smooth running of the programme.
  2. To undertake surveys on patterns of nutritional habits, home management and other needs of people in relation to the Home Economics programme.
  3. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
  4. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Senior Home Economics Officer in the roles ascribed to him.
