- Age Limit:** Between 18 and 30 years of age
- Qualifications:**
- A. (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry and Physics obtained at not more than two sittings or
 - (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry and Physics obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at Principal Level in at least two Science subjects including Chemistry obtained on one certificate or Passes in at least two Science subjects including Chemistry obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Training:

Selected candidates will be required to undergo training for a period of at least three years during which they will have to follow a course leading to a Diploma in Chemical Analysis and Instrumentation Techniques, as approved and arranged by the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life.

On successful completion of the training, including the obtention of the Diploma in Chemical Analysis and Instrumentation Techniques, Trainee Chemical Laboratory Technicians will be considered for appointment as Technical Officer (Chemical Laboratory), as and when vacancies occur.
