

**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE  
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Ministry:** Health and Quality of Life
- Post:** Principal Hospital Physicist
- Salary:** Rs 50,000 x 1,500 – 56,000 x 2,000 – 62,000 (19 75 82)
- Effective Date:** 2 July 2009
- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Hospital Physicist who –
- (i) reckon at least five years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade;
  - (ii) possess administrative and managerial capabilities; and
  - (iii) possess good communication and interpersonal skills.
- Role and Responsibilities:** To be responsible for the advancement of Medical Physics in all its aspects.
- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Regional Health Director for:-
    - (a) the administration and management of the Medical Physics Department and Radioisotope Laboratories;
    - (b) the protection against ionising radiation hazards of patients, staff and members of the public attending the Radiological Department and/or the Medical Physics Department;
    - (c) the planning and implementation of the research projects in the field of Medical Physics and other technical co-operation projects such as the IAIE/AFRA projects, etc;
    - (d) the training of junior staff; and
    - (e) co-operating with other Ministries/Departments and Parastatal Bodies in the fields of nuclear physics and ionising radiation.
  2. To perform all IT related duties.
  3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Principal Hospital Physicist in the roles ascribed to him.
