Qualifications:

A. Diploma in Mechanical and Electrical Engineering of the University of Mauritius, with automobile engines and prime movers as a subject in the second year of the course leading to that diploma.

Or

Higher National Diploma in Automobile Engineering

Or

An alternative qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

B. At least one year's practical experience in the running of a garage.

C. A valid driving licence for goods vehicles, buses, vans and cars.

Duties:

1. To be responsible to the Permanent Secretary through the Scheduled Administrative Officer for:

- (a) the management and the supervision of the Transport Division (the garage as well as the transport fleet);
- (b) planification of the Division requirements and the implementation of approved programmes;
- (c) ensuring that all the divisions of the Ministry are provided with transport facilities as and when required;
- (d) ensuring that all vehicles are in proper running order;
- (e) planning and implementation of regular preventive maintenance service to all vehicles of the Ministry;

(f) liaising with the Head of the Mechanical Workshop, Ministry of Works, for major repairs that cannot be undertaken by the personnel of the Division; and,
