Post: Student Medical Laboratory Technician

Salary: Rs 7,175 : 7,500 : 7,675 : 7,850 (09 18 22)

Effective Date: 3 February 2006

Age Limit: Between 18 and 25 years of age

Qualifications:

- A. (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least English Language, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics obtained at not more than two sittings or
- (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least English Language, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or
- (c) An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at Principal Level in Chemistry, Mathematics and either Biology or Physics obtained on one certificate or Passes in Chemistry, Mathematics and either Biology or Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above.

Training:

1. Student Medical Laboratory Technicians will be required to undergo on-the-job training and to follow the course leading to a Diploma in Biomedical Sciences, as approved and arranged.
2. On successful completion of their training including the obtention of the Diploma in Biomedical Sciences, Student Medical Laboratory Technicians will be eligible for appointment to the grade of Medical Laboratory Technician, as and when vacancies occur.

Note

Student Medical Laboratory Technicians who fail to obtain the Diploma, but are awarded a Certificate in Biomedical Sciences from a recognised institution may be considered for appointment to the grade of Assistant Medical Laboratory Technician, as and when vacancies occur.
