OR


Equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Head, AIDS Unit for the performance of the following duties –
 - (i) participating actively in prevention and training programmes in HIV/AIDS;
 - (ii) providing treatment, care and support to people living with HIV and AIDS including anti-retroviral treatment and counselling;
 - (iii) visiting, examining and treating HIV and AIDS patients under treatment in hospitals and any other public health care institutions including prisons services;
 - (iv) participating in the monitoring and evaluation of the prevention and the treatment programmes, in the training of medical and paramedical personnel and in the procurement of drugs for people living with HIV and AIDS;



- (v) ensuring the collection of statistics relevant to his duties and submitting returns, as and when required;
 - (vi) submitting relevant reports to management, as and when required;
 - (vii) carrying out surveys and research work in his area of competence; and
 - (viii) attending committees and ensuring proper follow-up action.
2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the AIDS Physician in the roles ascribed to him.
