

**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Ministry:** Health and Quality of Life
- Post:** Specialist/Senior Specialist
- Salary:** Rs 47,500 x 1,250 – 50,000 x 1,500 – 56,000 x 2,000 – 68,000 (09 73 85)
- Effective Date:** 8 September 2009
- Qualifications:** Candidates should:-
- (i) be fully registered -
 - (a) as medical practitioner in accordance with section 22 of the Medical Council Act; and
 - (b) as specialist in accordance with section 23 of the Medical Council Act, in the relevant fields of speciality.
 - (ii) be able to communicate effectively and to interact with people at all levels.

Note

Specialists/Senior Specialists shall be known as Consultant in their respective fields on reaching salary point Rs 66,000.

Role and Responsibilities: To be responsible for the provision of an effective and efficient clinical service in his speciality.

- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Regional Health Director through the Consultant-in-Charge of the relevant field for the following:-
 - (i) to perform clinical and other work pertaining to his speciality;
 - (ii) to mentor and train junior medical, nursing and other health personnel;
 - (iii) to initiate and participate in surveys and research activities and publications; and
 - (iv) to contribute to the development of health programmes.
 2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
 3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Specialists/Senior Specialists in the roles ascribed to them.
