- Post:** Physiotherapy Assistant
- Salary:** Rs 9,400 x 200 – 10,200 x 250 – 11,700 x 300 – 13,800 x 400 – 15,000 x 500 – 16,000 x 600 – 20,200 (09 17 46)
- Effective Date:** 25 September 2012
- Qualifications:** A. A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics or Principles of Accounts and two Science subjects obtained on one certificate or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics or Principles of Accounts and two Science subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**Note**

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. Candidates should –
- (i) possess good communication and interpersonal skills;
  - (ii) have a good working attitude; and
  - (iii) be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

**NOTE**

Selected candidates will be appointed in a temporary capacity in the first instance and will be required to undergo training for a period of at least one year, as approved and arranged by the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life. On successful completion of the training, they will be considered for appointment as Physiotherapy Assistant in a substantive capacity.

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**Duties:**

1. To be responsible to the Physiotherapist and/or Senior Physiotherapist through the Senior Physiotherapy Assistant for –
  - (a) assisting the Physiotherapist and Senior Physiotherapist in the performance of routine physiotherapeutic treatments, as directed, in any hospital or other health institution; and
  - (b) supervising, observing and reporting on patients undergoing rehabilitation exercise.
2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Physiotherapy Assistant in the roles ascribed to him.



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
